Lunch Bunch Class Descriptions

Lunch Bunch is designed for children who are enrolled at NCNS looking to extend and enrich their school day. Three of the classes are open to our 3 year old students and all four classes are open to our 4 year old students. All classes Lunch Bunch classes are 11:20-12:40 (Please note: Great Books is not a Lunch Bunch class). A **nut-free** brown bag lunch should be sent with students that day.

- **Yoga Bash/Lunch Bunch:** Spring forward by building strength, flexibility and confidence through yoga poses and breathing techniques designed for children. Yoga Bash incorporates books, seasonal events and games to bring out your mini yogi. Weekly themes include geography, languages and nature and will incorporate elements such as affirmation, body benefits and brain balance. Class begins with 45 minutes of yoga and is followed by a 30-minute **nut-free brown bag lunch** from home and short open play time. This class is open to both 3 and 4 year olds and will be held on Mondays.
- **Great Books:** Each week this class will introduce a wonderful children's story book. The book will first be read to the children and then reinforced with art, cooking, dramatic play, motor activities and snack, all relating to the story. At the end of each day, the children will retell the story gaining skills in comprehension, language skills and expressive language. The students will also develop emerging reading skills and gain understanding of print concepts. "Great Books" is open to our Pre-k students, as well as, our 3-year-old classes, and will take place on class on **Thursday mornings from 9:00- 11:15am**. Students enrolled in this course will have priority enrollment for the Thursday Lunch Bunch course, "Sing with Señora," which is taught from 11:20am – 12:40pm.
- **Sing with Señora/Lunch Bunch:** Students will be too busy having fun singing songs in Spanish and playing games to notice that they are also building a strong foundation for lifelong language learning! Preschoolers are at the PERFECT age to start learning another language. Sing with Señora makes that learning engaging and accessible through play, stories and song. Class begins with 45 minutes of activities, and is followed by a 30-minute **nut-free brown bag lunch** from home and short open play time. This class is open to both 3 and 4 year olds and will be held on Thursdays.
- **Jr. Engineers/Lunch Bunch (by Noggin Builders):** Explore early math and building skills in this hands-on program for preschoolers. Math is fun when we do it with hands-on projects from everyday life. Children will enhance skills like correspondence, spatial reasoning and comparisons as we engage in fun projects like measuring length, making "Pi" pieces, and creating their own abacus. As builders, the children will explore different types of materials, increasing their vocabulary of textures, shapes and material strength. They will use unusual building materials each week to build creations and enhance their abilities in building, such as balance and using connectors while practicing fine motor skills and creativity. Class begins with 45 minutes of activities, and is followed by a 30-minute **nut-free brown bag lunch** from home and short open play time. This class will be offered for both 3 and 4 year olds on Fridays.

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Refund Policy for NCNS Lunch Bunch

- If cancellation is received 21 days or more prior to the start of a session, NCNS will provide a full refund.
- If cancellation is received between 20 days prior to the start of a session and within 48 hours after the end of the second class, NCNS will provide a prorated refund for any classes not attended, less a \$35 cancellation fee.
- If cancellation is received more than 48 hours after the second class, NCNS will not issue any refunds unless the vacancy (created by this cancellation) is filled by a child on the waiting list. If a refund is issued, the refund amount will be prorated, less a \$35 cancellation fee.
