Pre-K Program <b>"Koalas" &amp; "Pandas"</b>   5-Day Pre-K (Class capacity: 14 students per class)	Age 4 by 9/1/23	<b>Monday through Friday</b>  12:45-3:00pm	In this program, children explore areas of interest through hands-on activities and investigation. On a daily basis, there are small and large group activities, dramatic play, creative art, scientific exploration, storytelling and literature, and outdoor play. The four-year-old classes take two field trips per year, with the locations dependent on interests of the children. This class helps children develop the necessary pre-reading and pre-writing skills needed for kindergarten. Classes are held 5 days per week without a parent.	\$4,984  \$100 registration fee included
